Four principles should guide our stewardship offerings.

PLAN - Intentionally set aside money from our budget to give away. An efficient way to plan our giving is to give weekly or monthly instead of yearly.

PERCENTAGE - Pick a percentage to give away, keeping in mind the biblical standard of the tithe or giving ten percent back to God.

PROGRESSIVE - Our goal over time is to increase the percentage of our income that we give away. As God blesses us financially we recognize that we have been blessed to bless others through our stewardship offering. *Please consider increasing your pledge for 2021.*
